
2nd Annual Butte Valley 4-H & Open Youth Field Day July 27-28, 2013 at the Butte Valley Community Park, Dorris, CA







One horse per rider rule per division, 4H/FFA participants must be in good standing. Hi-Point and Reserve awards will be given to high point in each group for pleasure classes and in each group for gymkhana classes. All riders regardless of 4H, FFA or Open will be judged together but awarded separately. Hi-Point Awards will be given in Showmanship and Ribbons for Project Boards. Ribbons will be awarded $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ place. Points given in accordance with placing (6 points for 1^{st} , 5 points for 2^{nd} , etc. regardless of number in the class). Ties will be decided as follows, rider with the most firsts is awarded Hi-Point. Age as of January 1, 2013. All riders must wear long sleeve shirt, boots and hat (no ball caps). No Show clothes necessary or 4H Whites. NO HELMET, NO BOOTS, NO RIDE ONLY APPLIES TO 4H & FFA. HELMET IS REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES when handling a horse. Horse must be sound, at judge's discretion. Any discourtesy, disobedience or unsafe conduct is grounds for disqualification. Tack changes will be 15 minutes.

No pens will be provided for Cattle, Goat's, Sheep, Rabbits, or Swine, you are welcome to setup temporary pens. All Steers and Heifers must be halter broke (NO EXCEPTIONS), any unruly livestock owner will be asked to leave. No washing on site. All livestock animals must be in good health, if animal appears to be ill, owner and animal will be asked to leave. 1st and 2nd place awards will be given in livestock showmanship classes, with ribbons to 6th place. Ribbons and Best In Show will be awarded for educational displays, and there will also be several 'just for fun' Livestock Contests that any exhibitor can enter at the event time, no entry fee.
