Siskiyou Golden Fair

New for 2007! The Siskiyou County 4-H program will be sponsoring a new educational event. This year on Saturday we will be hosting a horse, swine, beef, rabbit/cavy and sheep Knowledge Bowl. These events will take place in the main arena in the livestock area of the Siskiyou Golden Fair. The contests will take place in the following order.

11:30-12:15	Horse Knowledge Bowl
12:45-1:15	Swine Knowledge Bowl
1:20-1:50	Beef Knowledge Bowl
1:55-2:25	Rabbit/Cavy Knowledge Bowl
2:30-3:00	Sheep Knowledge Bowl

You need not have pre-arranged teams in order to be involved in the contest. Knowledge Bowls are a question and answer event where the contestants use buzzers to signal that they have the correct answers. (Similar to Jeopardy).
