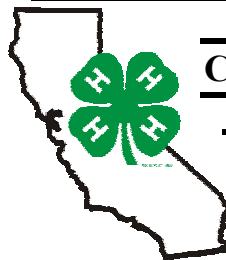

The University of California 4-H Youth Development Program announces its 2008 4-H Golden Clover Award recipients. 4-H Golden Clover Awards recognizes statewide outstanding achievement within the 4-H Youth Development Program. Nineteen 4-H Golden Clovers were awarded from a pool of seventy-eight nominations.



**Alyssa Schmidt, Siskiyou County** Collaboration and Outreach  
Alyssa introduced 380 students, approximately 70% of Siskiyou county's 4th grade population, to 4-H through a planned educational agricultural event.

Partnering with the Cattlewomen, Farm Bureau and Siskiyou Golden Fair, Alyssa planned a 4-H hands-on day to teach 4th graders about agriculture through a southwestern cattle round-up perspective. Through

her nine years in 4-H, Alyssa has engaged community members in understanding domestic violence and participated in a youth juvenile justice court program.

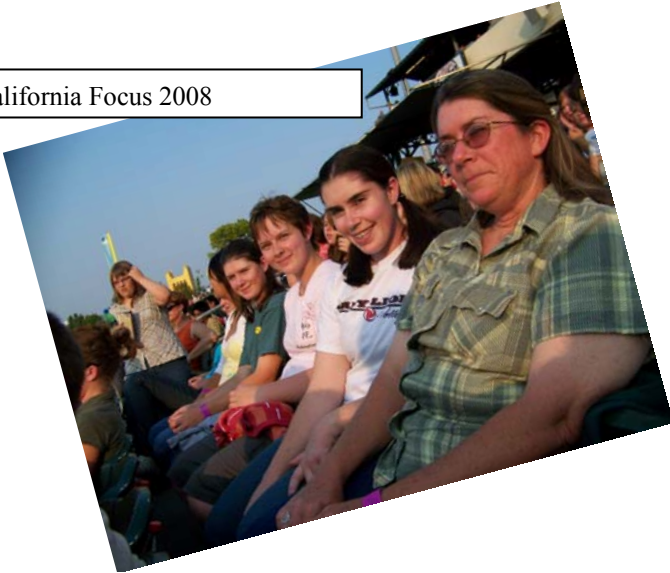
