## National 4-H Conference

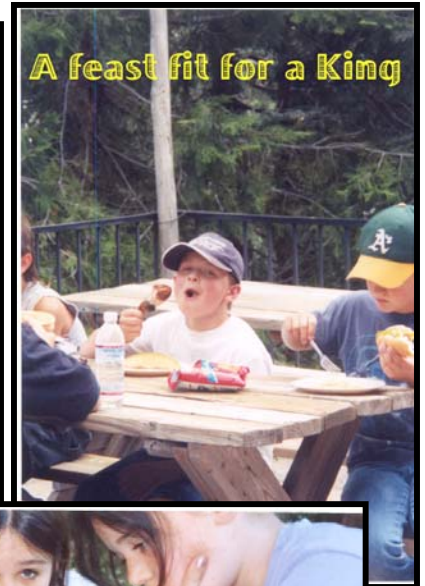
