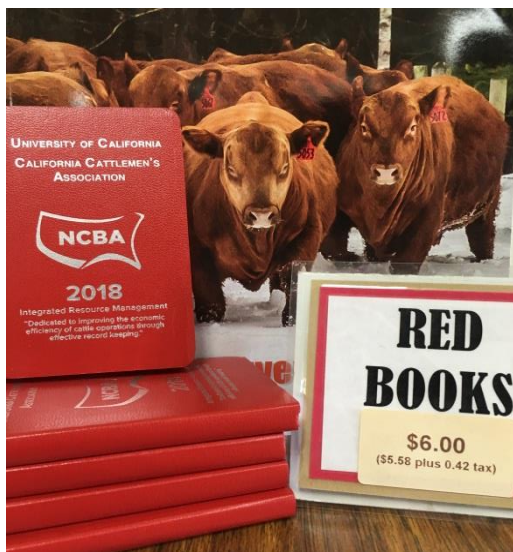

The Red Book is a pocket-sized record keeping book with more than 100 pages to record calving activity, herd health, pasture usage, rotation and cattle inventory. It serves as a date book with pages for notes and an address section. Red Books also include Beef Quality Assurance national guidelines and proper injection technique information. These are useful for any species. Books are \$6.00 (Checks preferred) and can be picked up at the UC Cooperative Extension Office located at 1655 S. Main St., Yreka, CA 96064.
